

## CAMPING CHECK LIST

The Boy Scout motto is "Be Prepared!" These are the basic items that every scout needs to bring on a camping trip.

- External frame backpack
- · Sleeping bag and ground pad
- Mess kit, utensils and cup
- Scout Handbook and pencil
- Matches
- Compass
- Flashlight
- Water bottle
- Wipes and Toilet paper
- Camping pillow
- Hiking boots
- Rain Poncho
- Extra set of weather appropriate clothing:
  - o Underwear
  - o Sox
  - o Pants
  - o Shirt
  - o Footwear
  - o Hat
  - Gloves
  - o etc...
- Rope for knot tying.
- Toothbrush and paste.
- Hand sanitizer
- Personal food items (If desired):
  - Healthy snack (i.e., energy bar)
  - o Powered drink mix
  - Hot Chocolate or Tea bags
  - o Sweetener
- Scout Spirit!
  - A scout should always come on a trip with a positive attitude and be ready to work together with the Patrol Leaders, adults and each other.

## What not to bring:

- Cell Phones: This item is not necessary since adults carry them in case of
  emergencies. The phone can be a distraction and can be easily lost. If any issue
  should occur you will be contacted by a troop leader. Always assume we have arrived
  at our destination safely.
